Chat Roles

Greeter The greeter opens the chat, introduces the moderators, acknowledges and welcomes participants and makes sure people feel good about being in the chat. This person also keeps track of how many people join and thanks participants for the comments and resources they share.

Moderator(s) The moderator posts questions, responds to questions and comments, and keeps the conversation going. Two moderators may be necessary for fast-paced chats.

Archivist Tweets can fly during a live chat, so archiving is extremely important. The archivist reviews, summarizes and reports on what happened during the live chat. Storify (storify.com) is a free and easy way to archive a Twitter chat.
